

Information for Homeschool School Student Participating in Interscholastic Athletics at Covenant

Homeschooled students seeking to participate in a sport will need to meet the following Covenant admissions requirements, submit the necessary documents, complete the admissions process, and pay fees listed below:

Admissions Requirements:

- Family professes faith in Jesus Christ
- Family is an active member of a local Bible-believing church
- Students should score in the 60th percentile or above on standardized testing
- Agree to abide by Covenant Student Handbook
- Attend a brief one-time family conference with the Upper School principal, Dr. Belk. We require that at least one parent attend the conference with the student.

Necessary Documents:

- Online application. Please visit www.WeAreCovenant.org to complete an online New Student Application. Instructions on how to start and complete the application are included.
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Current year's report card, as well as (2) previous year's report cards OR Transcript with this information
- Copy of standardized test scores taken within past year. If no standardized test scores are available, we will schedule a time for your student to come in for testing at Covenant.
- Church Reference- Included in the online application is a place for you to enter a pastor or church leader's email address for a Church Reference to be completed on your behalf.
- Additional Documents required by Athletic Department

Fees to Participate:

- \$125 Application Fee (Due when submitting online application)
- \$400 Athletic Fee per Sport for the first sport. \$250 for each additional sport. (Checks can be made out to *Covenant School of Jacksonville*) If you would like to make a Credit/Debit Card payment, please reach out to Theresa Varnes at 904-801-1076 or tvarnes@wearecovenant.org
